Your landfill ticket will be included in your March utility bill. Each household or business with active CITY refuse service at the time of the March utility bill mailing will receive ONE ticket for this event.

\*Please stop and recycle allowed recyclable items at the County Rd depot before making your way to the landfill.

\*Each customer is allowed up to 800 lbs. with their ticket.

\*Each customer is allowed up to 4 tires that do not exceed 24" diameter. ALL TIRES ARE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE RIM.

\*No E-waste accepted (televisions, computers, printers, etc.) – Please E-cycle them. It is FREE! Call for information.

\* No automotive or lithium-ion batteries allowed. – Please recycle them. Most locations that sell new ones will take your old ones.

\*All loads must be covered & secured - fee may be charged on loads not secured or tarped.

\*Customers are required to unload their own waste as directed by the site monitor.

\*Customers must have utility ticket & current utility bill.

\*Event is for city-refuse paying customers ONLY.

\*One ticket will be issued per customer in their March bill. If you do not have services during the March billing, our next event will be in October or you can contact us for additional service options.

**We suggest that you load your waste according to type such as:**

- Tires (up to limit, size and off rims)
- Appliances/Metal (ranges, refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.) These items can also be hauled to the County Rd Recycle Depot during hours all year long for FREE!
- Brush (only natural materials – cannot have paint, stain, nails, etc.)
- Garbage (regular household waste – bag and tie all small items)

This will help expedite the time it takes for you to sort and unload at the site.

**ABSOLUTELY NO hazardous waste, burn barrels, automotive batteries, tires mounted on wheels, televisions or computers.**

# REDUCE, REUSE & RECYCLE!

## 1. Recycle

Newspaper, cardboard, glass, tin, aluminum, used motor oil and scrap metal – including your old appliances are accepted. Save yourself a trip to the landfill!

## Reuse

Have something you no longer need, but is still in good condition? Consider donating it, have a yard sale, post it online as FREE! Someone may find a treasure in your old item.

## 2. Refuse = trash

Items not recyclable at the depots or in decent condition to be reused will need to be taken to the landfill during the dates and times of this event only, if you wish to use this opportunity.

## Expanded Recycling Opportunity

Why go to the landfill get your car dirty and wait in line, if items can be recycled? Save the dirt, time and gas money & take your recyclable items to the County Road depot FRIDAY 4/11 AND SATURDAY 4/12!



### RECYCLING OF YOUR OLD METAL ITEMS OFFERED ALL YEAR LONG!

Have an old appliance to get rid of? Try donating it if it still works. If not, we have a great option!

Haul it for free to our County Road Recycling Depot for FREE year-round on Tuesdays & Thursdays between 12 (Noon) and 4 p.m. or Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 12 (Noon).

Also accepted at this location: scrap metal, aluminum, tin, glass, used residential motor oil, corrugated cardboard and newspaper!

Please do your part to keep these materials out of the landfill. Not only does this help keep waste out of the landfill but it also keeps landfill operating costs down, which allows for these events and keeps our rates down!

During the year between these events, we also offer temporary additional garbage services to meet your needs.

Please: Do not overload your garbage cans.

Bag and tie your trash.

Place the can with the opening facing the street

by 5 a.m. on your collection day or the night before. No computers or televisions at any time!

No tires allowed at any time!
