**RECYCLING BEGINS WITH YOU!** Recycling isn't just about putting it in a bin to be taken to a facility to be made into something else and used again!

Recycling begins with **REDUCING** the amount of waste and unnecessary materials by choosing more sustainable long-term use items from packaging to furnishings and more. Growing out of something doesn't mean it is trash. If it is in relatively good condition and could still serve a purpose try donating it or selling it as part of the **REUSE** process of recycling. Many find great use out of slightly used items at yard sales, thrift stores and other market platforms for a fraction of the cost, if not free! When all else fails or it isn't in any kind of shape to be reconditioned or reused, sometimes **RECYCLING** is the best option. If you find that you have items that you no longer need, please check out our acceptable recycling items list first, before throwing them away. Not only are you saving space in your trash can for waste, but you may also be helping someone else to get something they could use at a fraction of the cost, if purchased new and you are also making the environmentally friendly decision to recycle.

### ITEMS ACCEPTED AT DEPOTS:

#### NEWSPAPER, PHONE BOOKS & MAGAZINES ONLY

No strings, rubber bands, plastic bags, boxes, etc.

#### GLASS

Glass jars and bottles ONLY. No drinking glasses, mirrors, ceramics, windows, dishes or light bulbs, etc. Labels are ok. Empty and remove

#### ALUMINUM & TIN

Please sort. Clean food containers only such as aluminum foil, pie plates, beverage cans to tin food cans/containers. La-

#### CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Clean, flattened corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags or packing materials. Call and ask about being added to our commercial collection route.

## E-Waste Disposal

### WHAT IS E-WASTE?

Also referred to as CED's or Covered Electronic Devices. The items below are not allowed in landfills:

#### Items Covered by Oregon E-Cycles



Back in 2010 Oregon prohibited the disposal of such devices in landfills.

**STOP! Do not put them in your garbage can or take them to the landfill.** E-CYCLE THEM!

### WHAT DO I DO WITH MY OLD CED's?

These items require special handling and cannot be collected for recycling via our recycling service or placed in your trash can. We can assist our refuse paying customers for a fee by collecting the item curbside and taking it to the disposal site for you. Otherwise you will need to take them and drop them off at the FREE collection site during the designated days and times. Humbert Refuse & Recycling has partnered with the City allowing our residents to dispose of their E-waste the right way for FREE at their location.

### WHERE DO I TAKE MY OLD CED's?

Humbert Refuse & Recycling accepts CED's from City of Milton-Freewater customers. They are located at 54841 Hwy 332, Milton-Freewater during the hours of 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday. Please leave accepted items only in the designated area between the office/shop and Hwy 332 only.
