LAST CHANCE FOR LEAF COLLECTION

Issue Date: December 13, 2024

Loose Leaves

DEADLINE: December 16

DEADLINE TIME: 7 a.m.

ROUTE: There is no designated route, so everyone needs to have their loose leaves out by the deadline.

- **LEAVES ONLY PLEASE.** No other yard debris or trash will be picked up.
- We will do one last pass through. Once we go by, we will not come back this year.
- Leave a minimum 2-foot clearance between leaves (bagged and loose) & fences, vehicles, etc.

Bagged Leaves

DEADLINE: CITY-WIDE REGULAR GARBAGE COLLECTION DAY – December 16-20

DEADLINE TIME: 7 a.m.

ROUTE: Regular garbage day. There is no designated collection time or route. Just a day of the week during business hours.

ATTENTION

Please do not overload your trash can, you will be charged an overload fee of \$21.18, if we can even empty it. If we cannot empty it, you will have to unload it so we can and then you may be assessed an off-route fee (\$21.18) for us to come back and empty it.

If you have leaves (loose or bagged) after your regular trash collection day next week (12/16-12/20/24), you will need to bag, tie and place them in your garbage can.

If leaves are placed out on the street after your garbage collection day next week you will be assessed fees for us to clean them up. Such fees will be billed based on actual costs for labor, equipment and landfill fees.

Let us help you find the best solution for proper disposal of your leaves and any extra waste you may have. We have options all year around, that cost less than overload fees—both temporary and regular options as follows:

- Temp 300 – you can have it for 2 weeks, dumped whenever you call. Each dump is \$27.50. We remove it after 2 weeks of use. You are eligible for this once every three (3) months.
- Monthly 300 – you can have it at the monthly rate and it is emptied on your regular garbage day. The cost is \$80.12 per month.
- Additional residential size 90 gallon can(s) – you can have them at the monthly rate for as long as you need for an additional \$17.73, per can, per month.
